ABOUT THE AWARD

The goal of the NAHB Associate of the Year and Society of Honored Associates Awards is to recognize associate members who have distinguished themselves by their outstanding contributions on the local, state and national levels to the home building industry and to NAHB.

ELIGIBILITY

Each state is invited to submit one nomination for the NAHB Associate of the Year and Society of Honored Associates Awards. Nominations will be accepted from state presidents, executive officers, or (in states without a state association) NAHB State Representatives. Nominees must be associate members in good standing with NAHB. Nominees who have previously been inducted into the NAHB Society of Honored Associates within the last two years will be automatically considered for the 2012 Associate of the Year Award. These nominees will be given the opportunity to update their entry.

<u>THE JUDGING</u>

A panel of five impartial judges select up to five outstanding entries. The most outstanding associate is named Associate of the Year and up to five are inducted into NAHB's prestigious Society of Honored Associates. All nominees and winners will be honored at the Associate Awards Presentation held during the annual International Builders' Show in Las Vegas, Nevada.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- Use only the application included in this kit (or on the NAHB website) to submit your entry.
 Be as concise as possible, providing only pertinent information. No additional materials will be accepted or considered by the judges.
- Nominees are judged in the following categories:
 - Association and Membership Activities
 - Local Association Activity (10%)
 - State Association Activity (10%)
 - National Association Activity (50%)
 - Industry Accomplishments (20%)
 - Civic Responsibility (10%)
- The judging takes place in November 2012.
 The panel of judges is composed of:
 - One Past NAHB President
 - One Past National Area Chair

- One Past Membership Committee Chair
- One Past NAHB Associate of the Year
- One Past Associate Members Committee Chair
- Print the abbreviated name of your state (not your candidate) in the space provided at the top of each page.
- Enclose a 5 x 7 head-and-shoulders (color if possible) photograph of the nominee. Include the name and state of the nominee on the back of the photo. A virtual slide show will be available at the International Builders' Show in Las Vegas, Nevada which is scheduled for January 2013.
- Entries and photos become the property of the Associate Members Committee and cannot be returned.

EXCEPTIONS

- Those persons inducted into the Society of Honored Associates will be automatically reconsidered for the Associate of the Year Award for two years following their induction.
- Induction into the Society of Honored Associates is for life. A member cannot be reinducted.
- If a member of the Society of Honored Associates is ever renominated by his or her state, he or she will be automatically re-entered into the two-year renomination pool for the Associate of the Year Award, whether or not he or she is judged to be in the top five.
