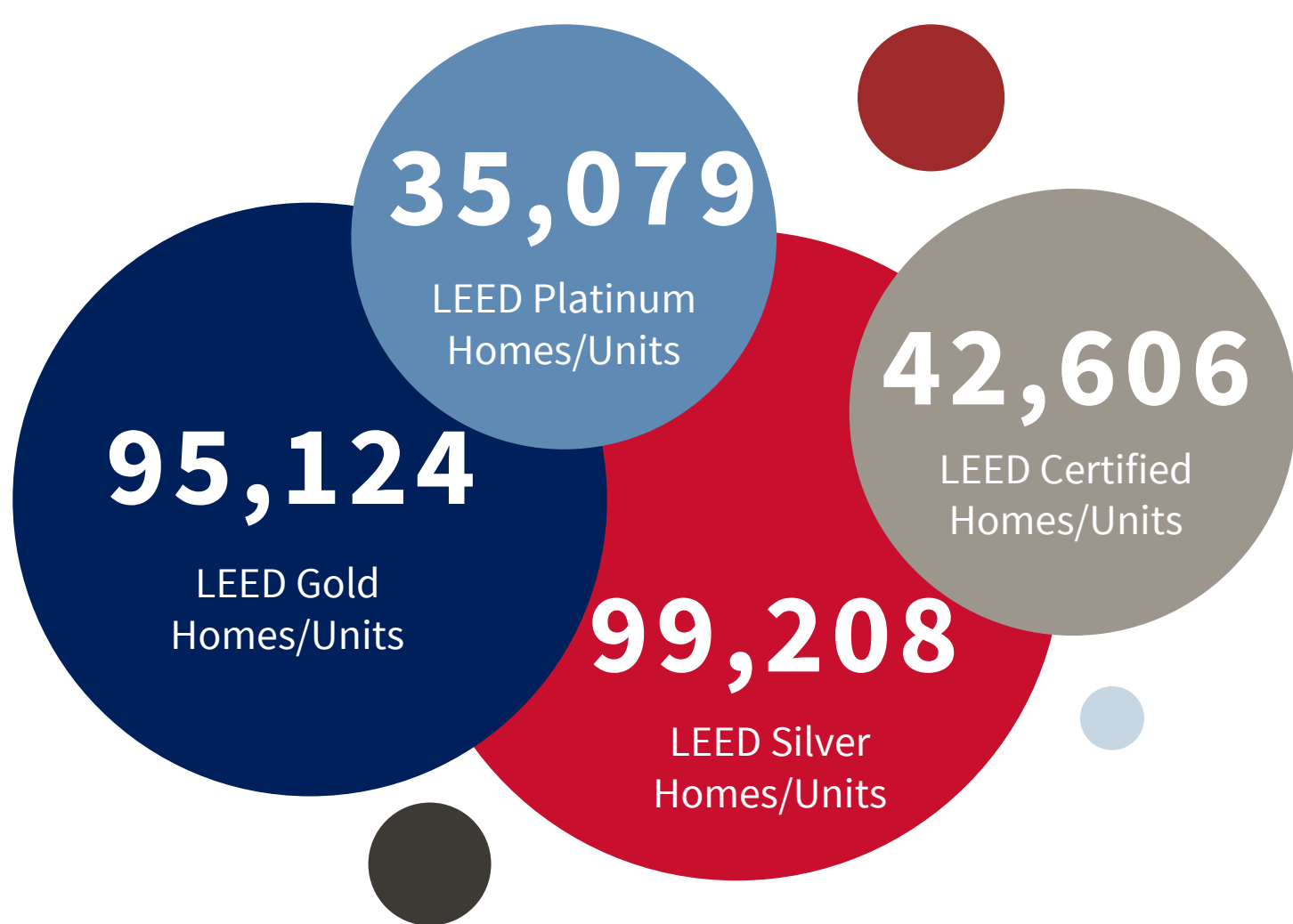


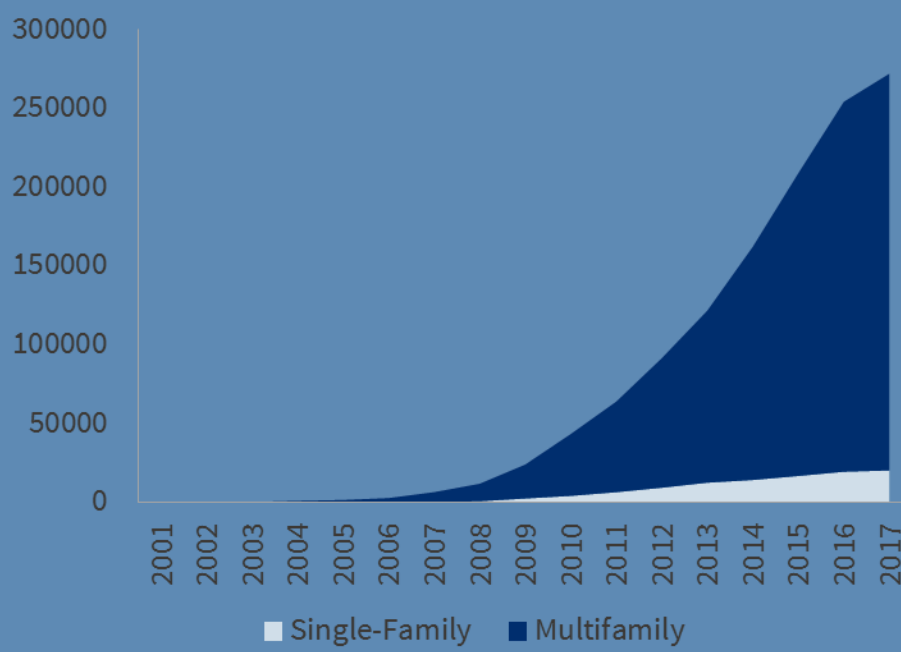
Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED)

The Increasing Certification Levels of LEED Residential Units

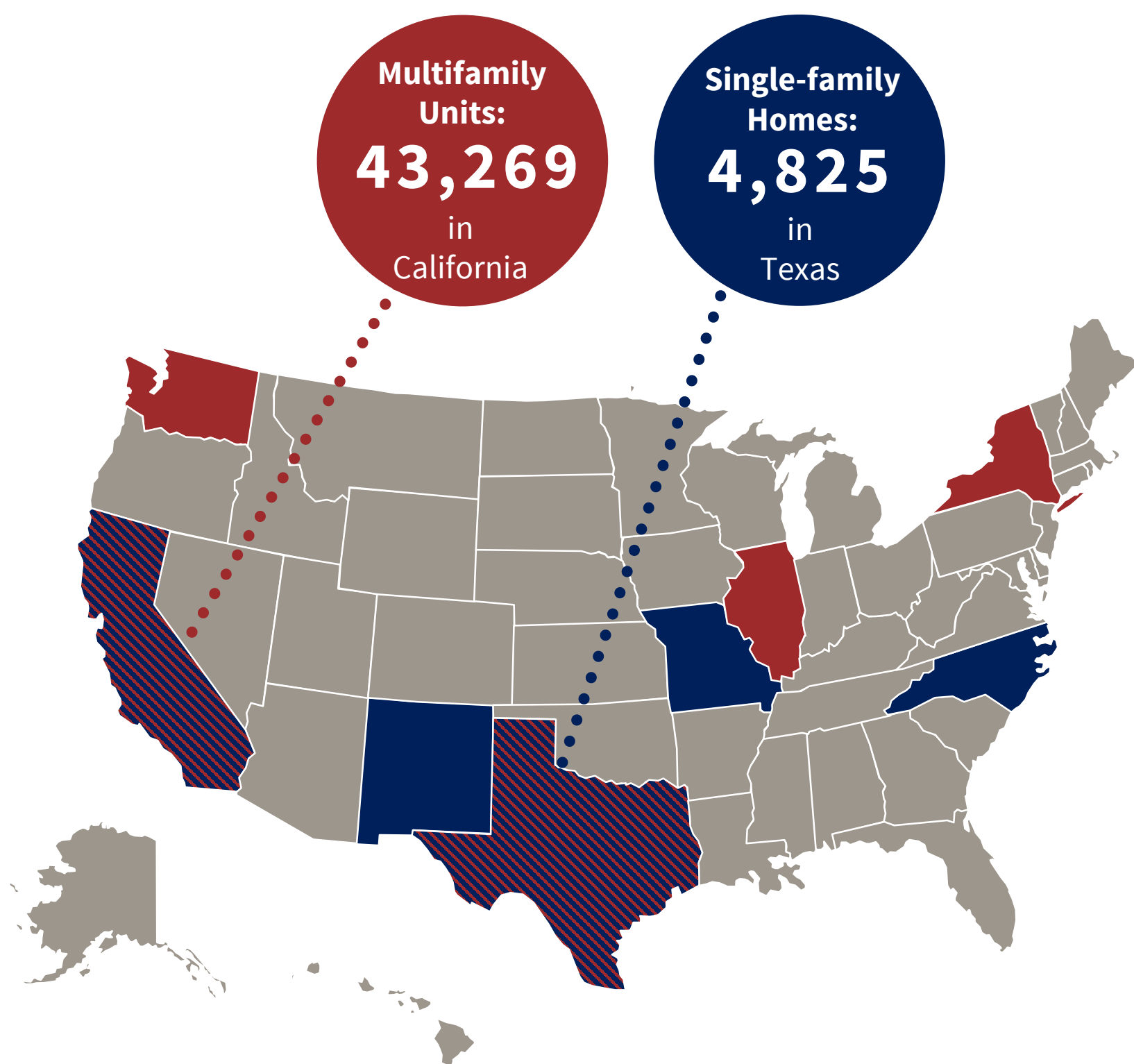
