# Prices of Goods and Services Used in Residential Construction

According to analysis of the most recent <u>release</u> of the Bureau of Labor Statistics Producer Price Index (PPI), the prices of goods used as inputs to residential construction including energy and excluding energy have risen 13.0 percent year-to-date (YTD), 11.1 percent, if the price of energy is excluded. In contrast, the overall index for all goods climbed 9.6 percent over the same period, or 6.6 percent excluding food and energy (Figure 1). An even larger disparity exists between YTD price changes of all services and those used in residential construction (excluding labor) which have increased 4.8 percent and 9.5 percent, respectively.






#### Materials Inputs

Although the decline in lumber prices since May 2021 has helped bring costs down (after having <u>driven them up drastically</u> earlier in the year), the decline has been offset by large increases in the prices of a multitude of other products.

Of the 103 goods included in the PPI for inputs to residential construction, the prices of the following 10 have increased the most since January 2020 (see Figure 2):



Four of these products are also among the 10 that have exhibited the largest price increases over the first nine months of 2021 (Figure 3).

Four of the goods on the top 10 year-to-date price increase list are metal goods, three are energy products (unleaded premium, unleaded mid-premium, and unleaded regular gasoline) and two categories of chemicals—phosphates and nitrogenates—round out the list. Asphalt (a petroleum derivative) is the final material on the year-to-date list but is absent from the 10 largest increases relative to pre-pandemic prices.



Due to the volatile nature of their prices, energy goods are frequently subtracted from overall price indices. If the goods above were limited to non-energy products, domestic water heaters (+33.8 percent), wood pallets and pallet containers (+33.3 percent), and non-current carrying wiring devices (+32.2 percent) would round out the largest price increases since the start of 2021.


Some building materials and inputs to building materials have seen especially acute increases over the past three months. Of the goods analyzed here, 14 experienced price increases exceeding 10 percent between May and August (Figure 4).

Although the price of wood products such as lumber and structural panels have declined sharply since reaching record highs in May, they make up a minority of the PPI for goods inputs to residential construction. Nonmetallic mineral products and metals and metal products each make up a larger share (Figure 5).

## Services Inputs

As noted above, the price of services used as inputs to residential construction has outpaced the price of services economy-wide by a large margin since the beginning of 2020. Year-to-date, the PPI for services used in residential construction has risen at nearly three times the rate of the PPI for all services in the economy (Figure 1)


The wholesaling and retailing of building materials and supplies together account for 61.3 percent of the PPI for services used in residential construction. The top five most heavily weighted services are rounded out by engineering, long-distance freight transportation, and wholesaling of parts and supplies for machinery and equipment (Figure 6).

Services can be grouped by category, allowing for simpler interpretation (Figure 7). Retailing and wholesaling of all products (not just building materials) account for roughly two-thirds of the effect services prices have on the residential construction inputs PPI. Engineering accounts for most of the contribution from professional services, but the category also includes legal and architectural services. Transportation includes local and long-distance motor carrying only, as other modes of transit are folded into the cost of goods in the full index.



#### **Price Increases**

The prices of eight services included in the PPI for inputs to residential construction have risen more than 20 percent since the start of 2020. Figure 8 shows the services with the 10 largest price increases since January 2020.



Six of these services inputs to residential construction are also among the 10 biggest year-to-date price increases. While the composition of the two lists is similar, the order is quite different (except that metals, minerals, and ores wholesaling is first on each list).


Four services—major household appliance retailing, securities brokerage and investment advice, hardware and building materials retailing, and parts and supplies for machinery and equipment wholesaling,—drop out of the top ten and are replaced by furnishings wholesaling, paper and plastics products wholesaling, cleaning supplies and paper products retailing, and self-service storage and miniwarehouses, gross rents. Cleaning supplies and paper products retailing has the second highest price increase in 2021, while building materials wholesaling and long-distance motor carrying moved up four and three spots, respectively.

Price increases of services inputs to residential construction over the past three months have been modest relative to the recent price movements of goods exhibited in Figure 4. Six of 37 services items (16.2 percent) increased greater than five percent in price compared with 27 of 103 goods, or 26.2 percent of the total (Figure 10).

#### Price Declines

Not every good and service weighted in the inputs to residential construction PPI has risen in price over the past 20 months. The price indices of three goods and seven services have declined since January 2020:

### Goods

- Industrial sand (-8.0 percent)
- Paving mixtures and blocks (-3.5 percent)
- Nonclay refractories (-0.3 percent)

#### Services

- Securities brokerage, dealing, and related services (-35.7 percent)
- Deposit services (-9.9 percent)
- Household fuels retailing (-7.2 percent)
- Nonresidential property management fees (-5.5 percent)
- Rental and leasing of construction, mining, and forest machinery and equipment (-3.5 percent)
- Other loans and loan services (-1.0 percent)
- Other credit intermediation services, including trust services (-0.8 percent)

Seven goods and four services inputs to residential construction have experienced price declines over the first nine months of 2021:

#### Goods


- Softwood lumber; not edge-worked (-39.1 percent)
- Treated wood (-14.6 percent)
- Softwood veneer and plywood (-10.5 percent)
- Softwood cut stock and dimension (-9.7 percent)
- Paving mixtures and blocks (-2.3 percent)
- Kaolin and ball clay (-0.1 percent)
- Contract wood preservation (-0.1 percent)

## Services

- Nonresidential property management fees (-1.2 percent)
- Other credit intermediation services, including trust services (-1.1 percent)
- Deposit services (-0.2 percent)
- Books retailing (-0.1 percent)

Although these price declines alleviate upward price pressures elsewhere, the effect is almost negligible. Not only is the number of weighted goods and services that have fallen in price small relative to the total, but the total weight for which these line items account is diminutive. Figure 11 shows the total index weight by price direction for each of the comparison periods above.
