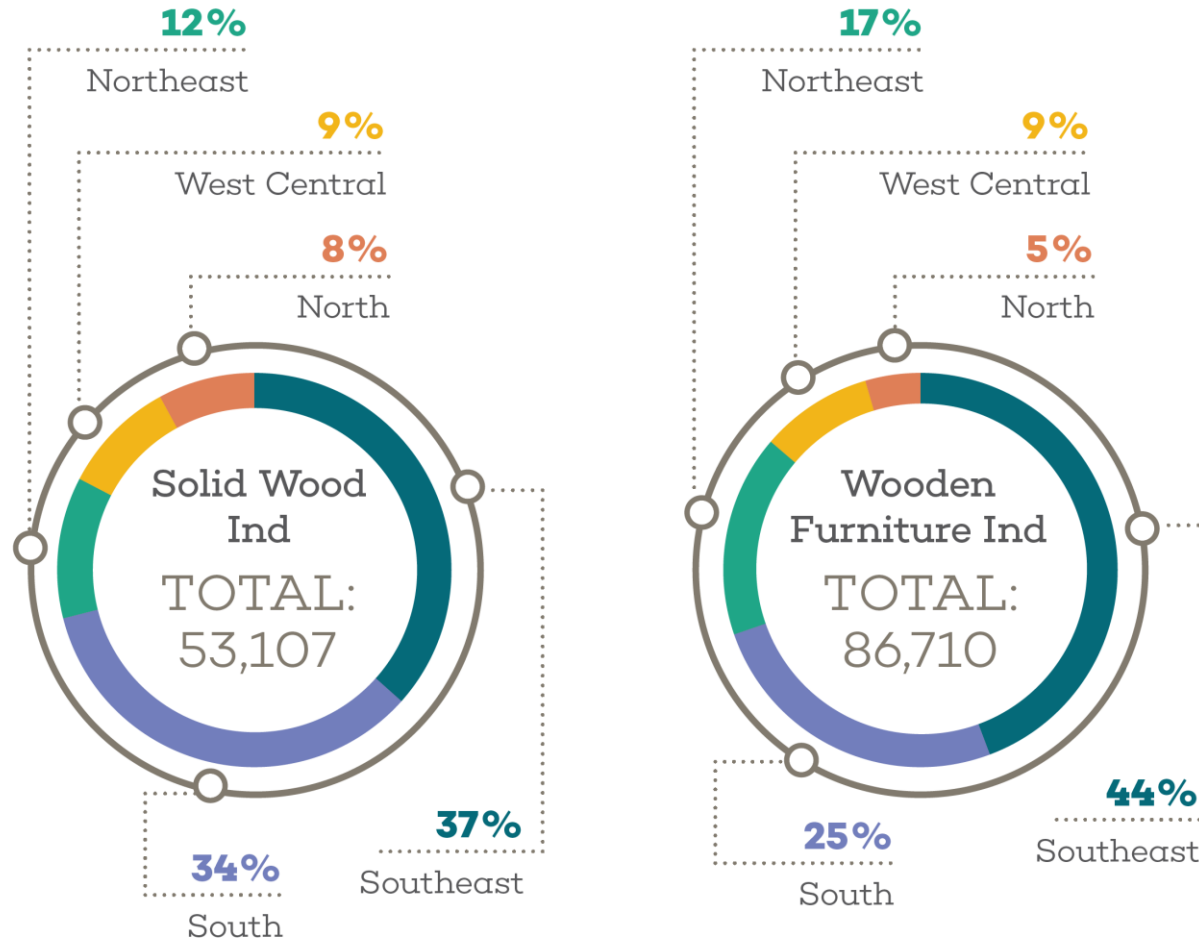

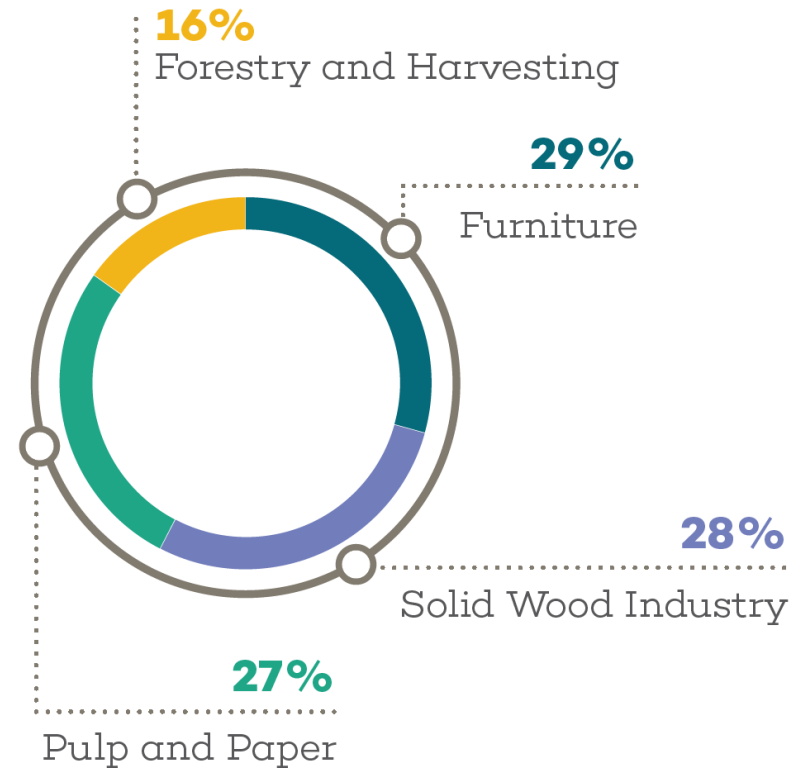
NUMBER OF COMPANIES¹ BY SEGMENT AND REGION (2018)



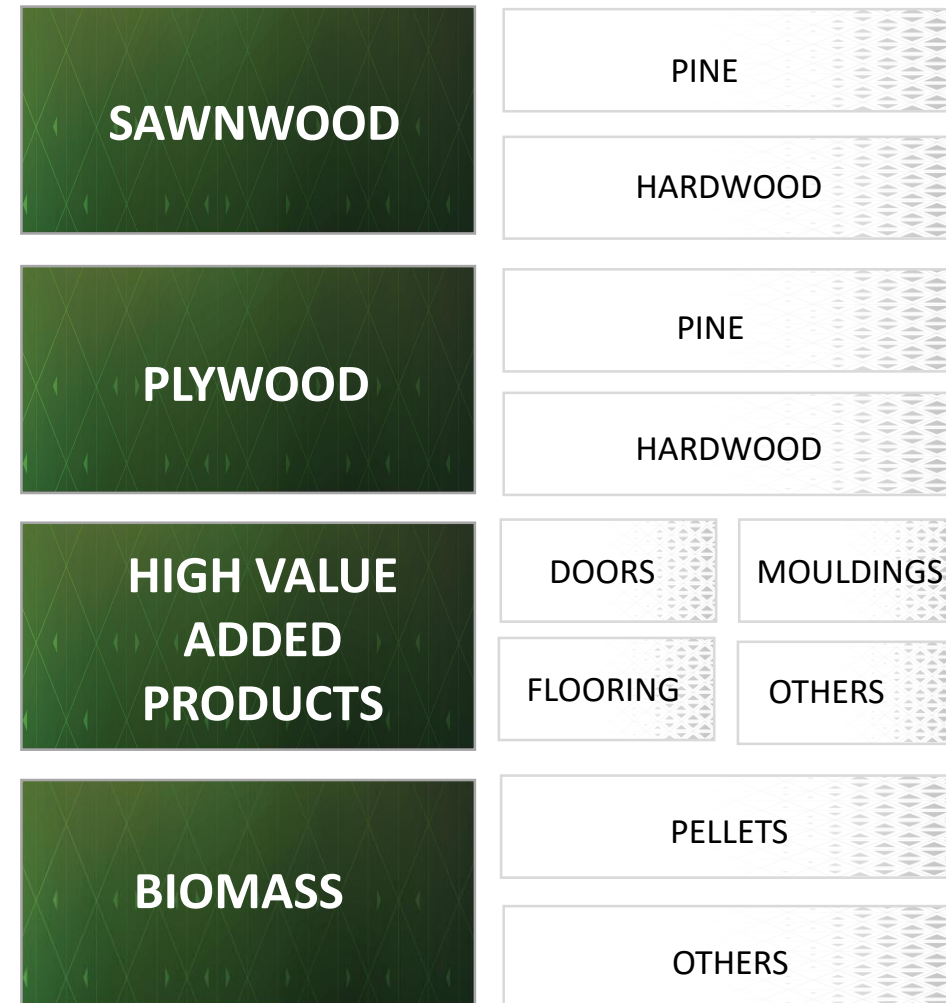
SHARE BY SEGMENT IN NUMBER OF JOBS (2018¹)

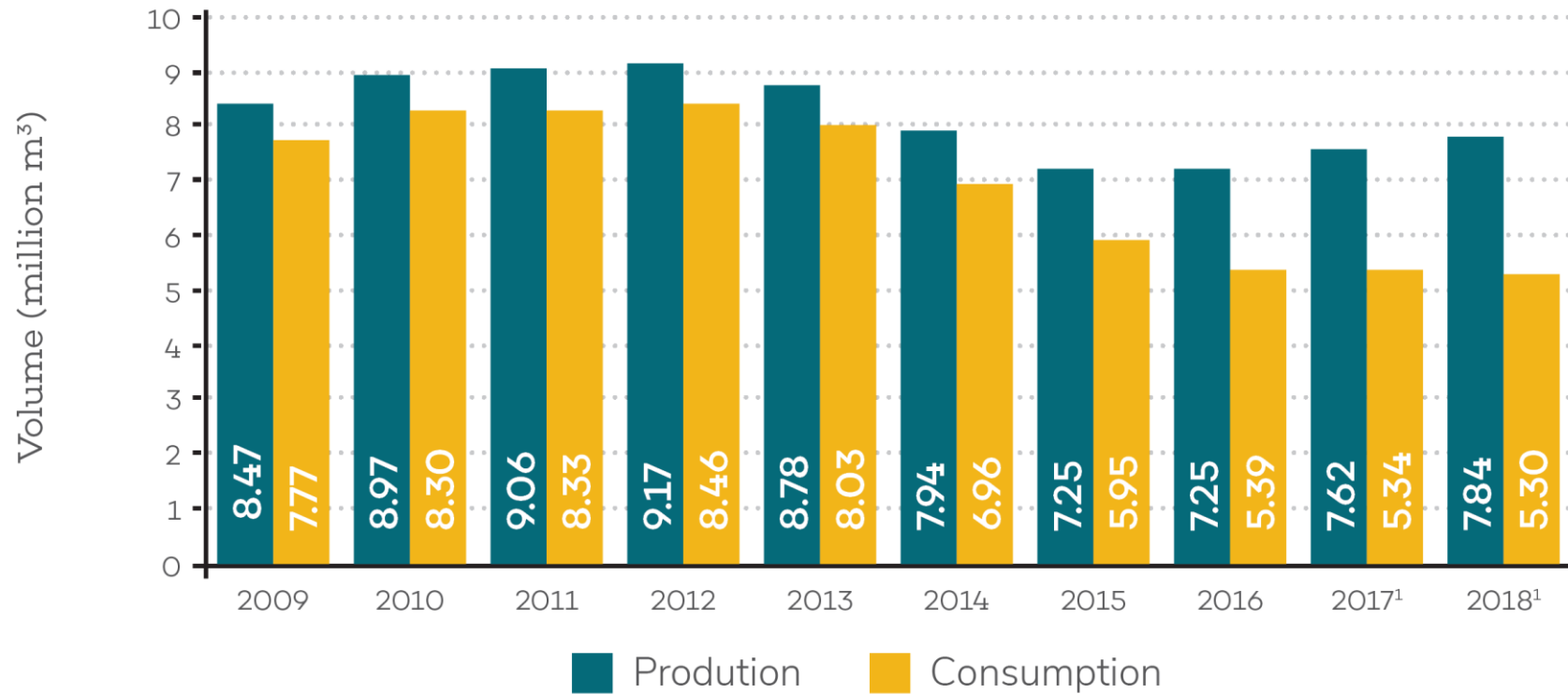


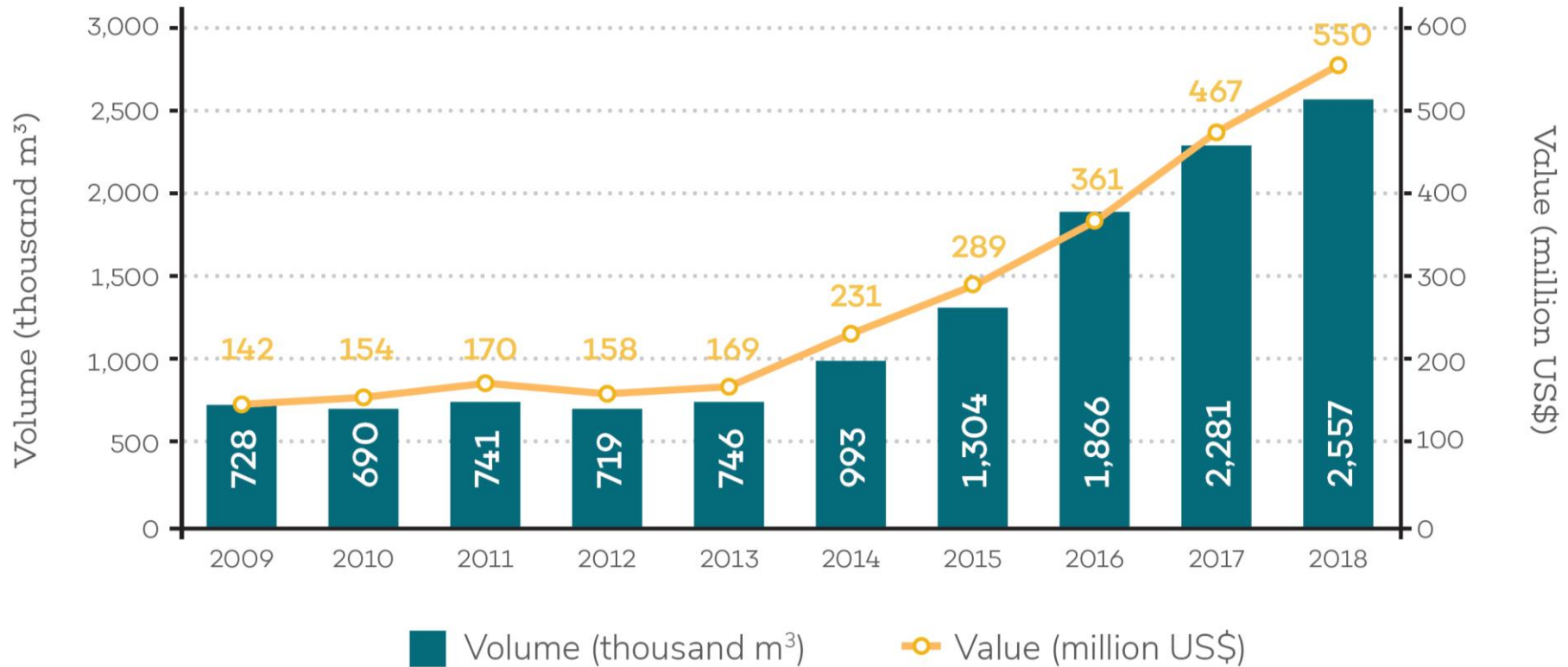

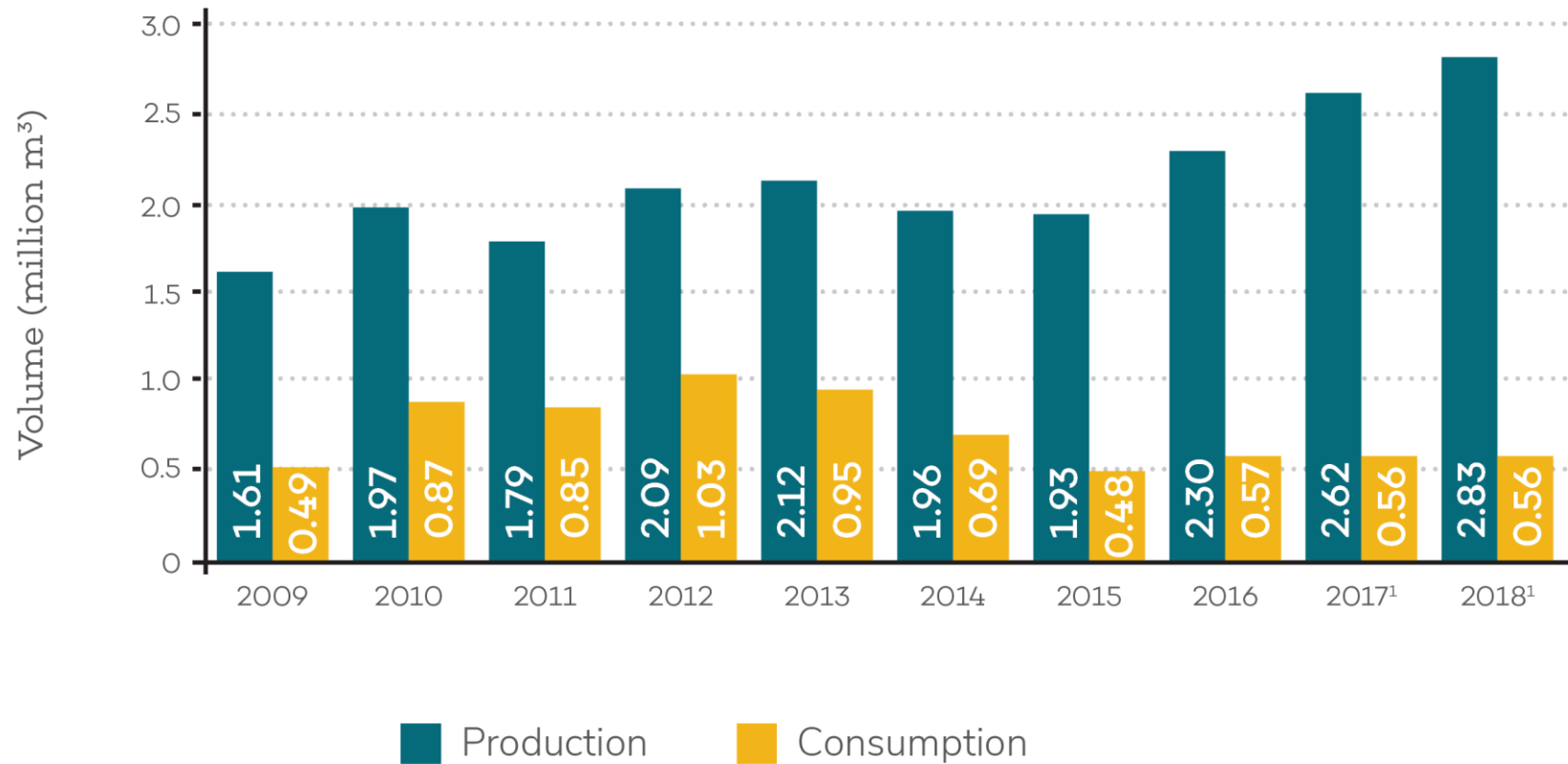


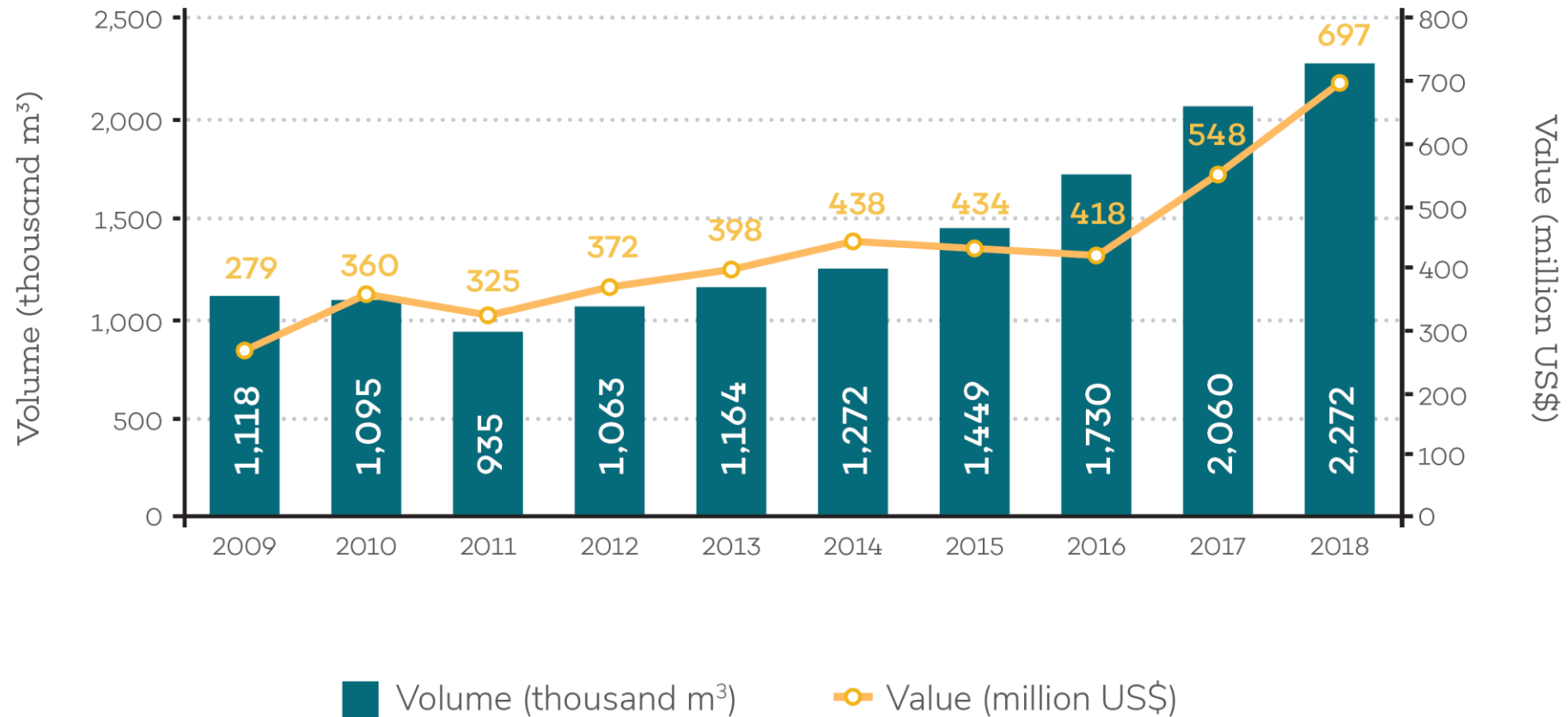


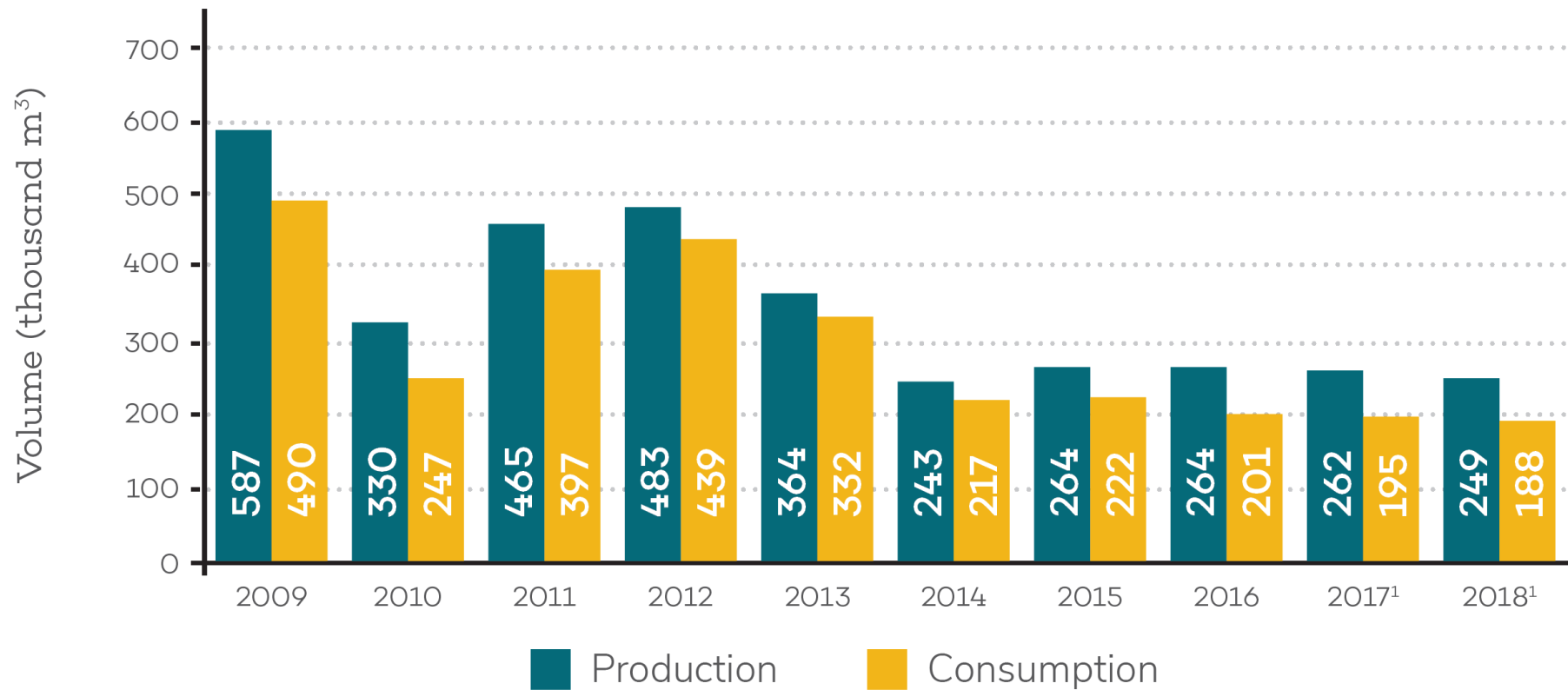


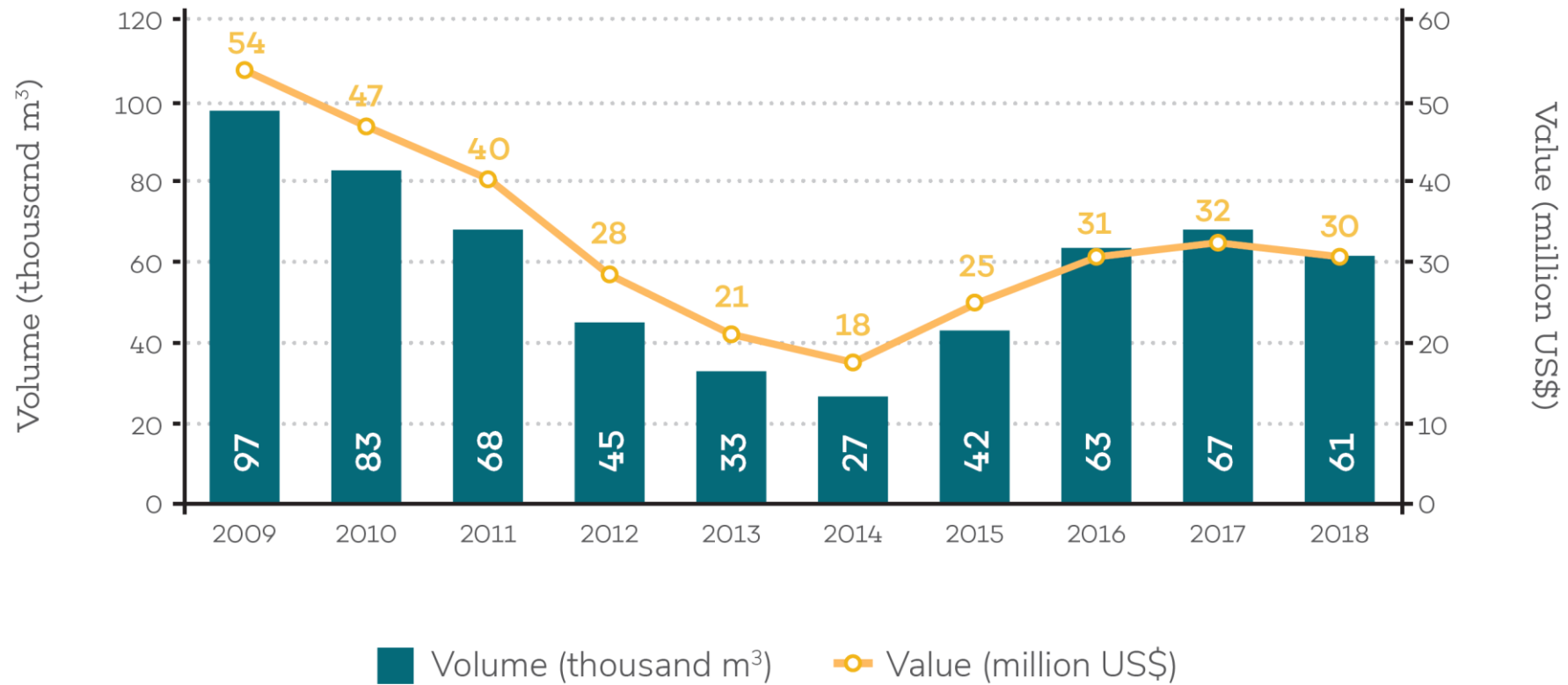


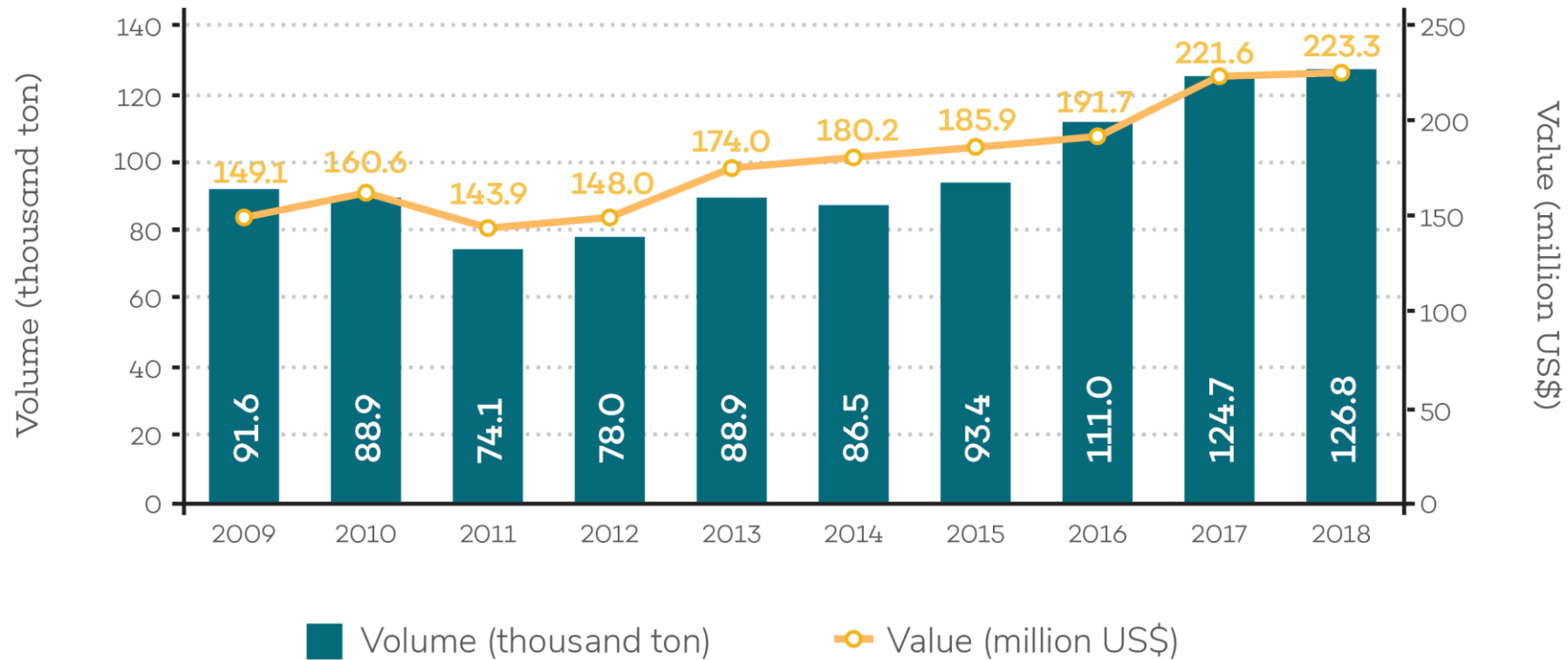


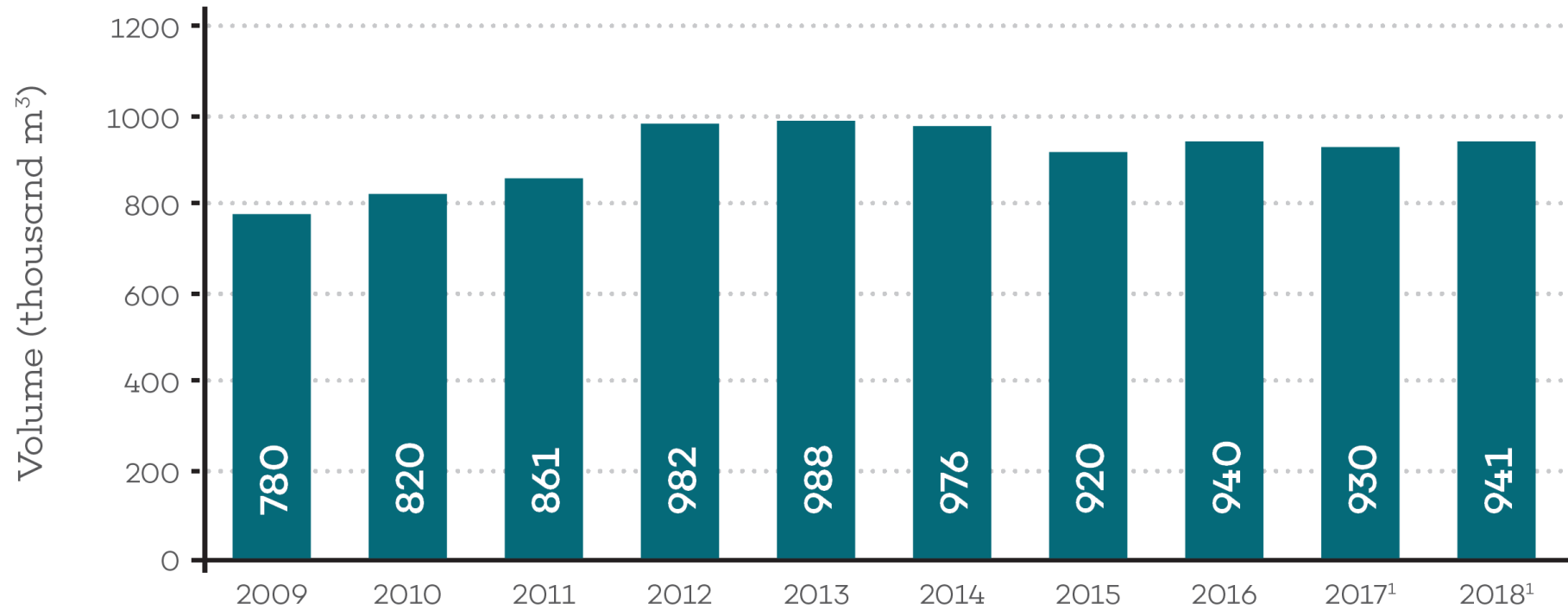


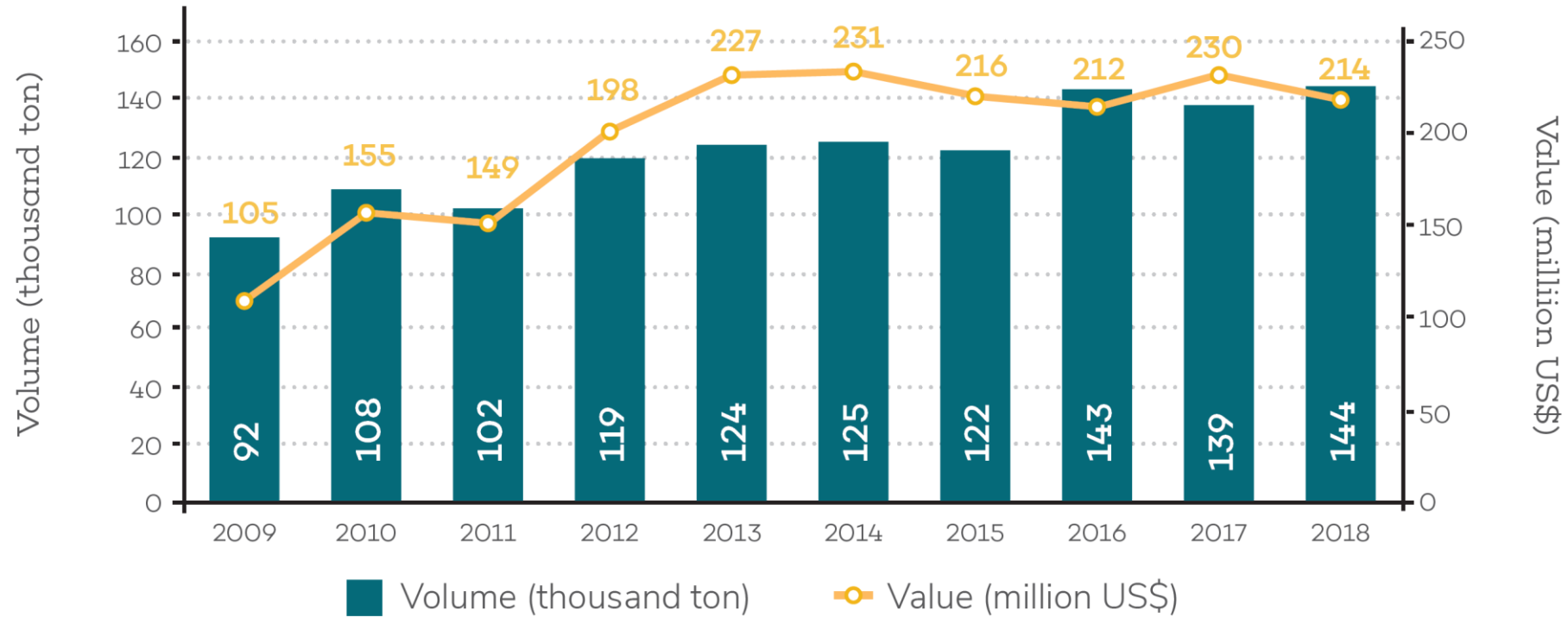


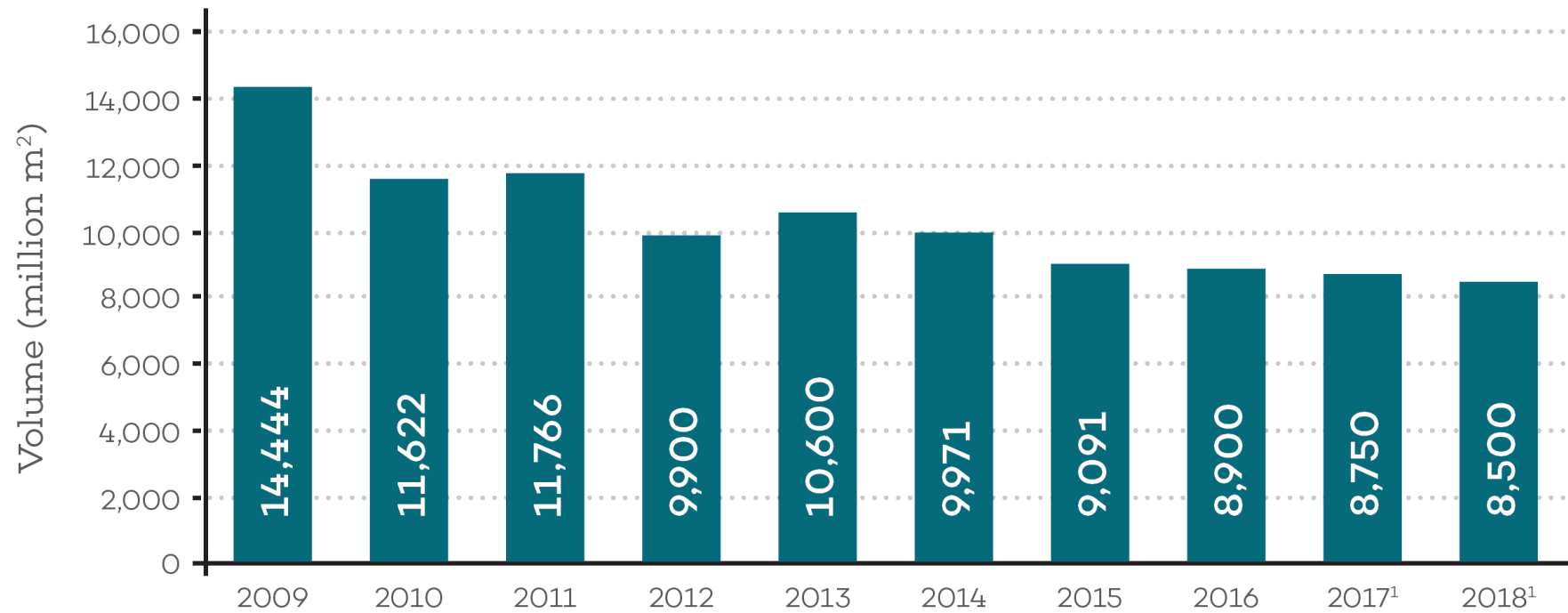


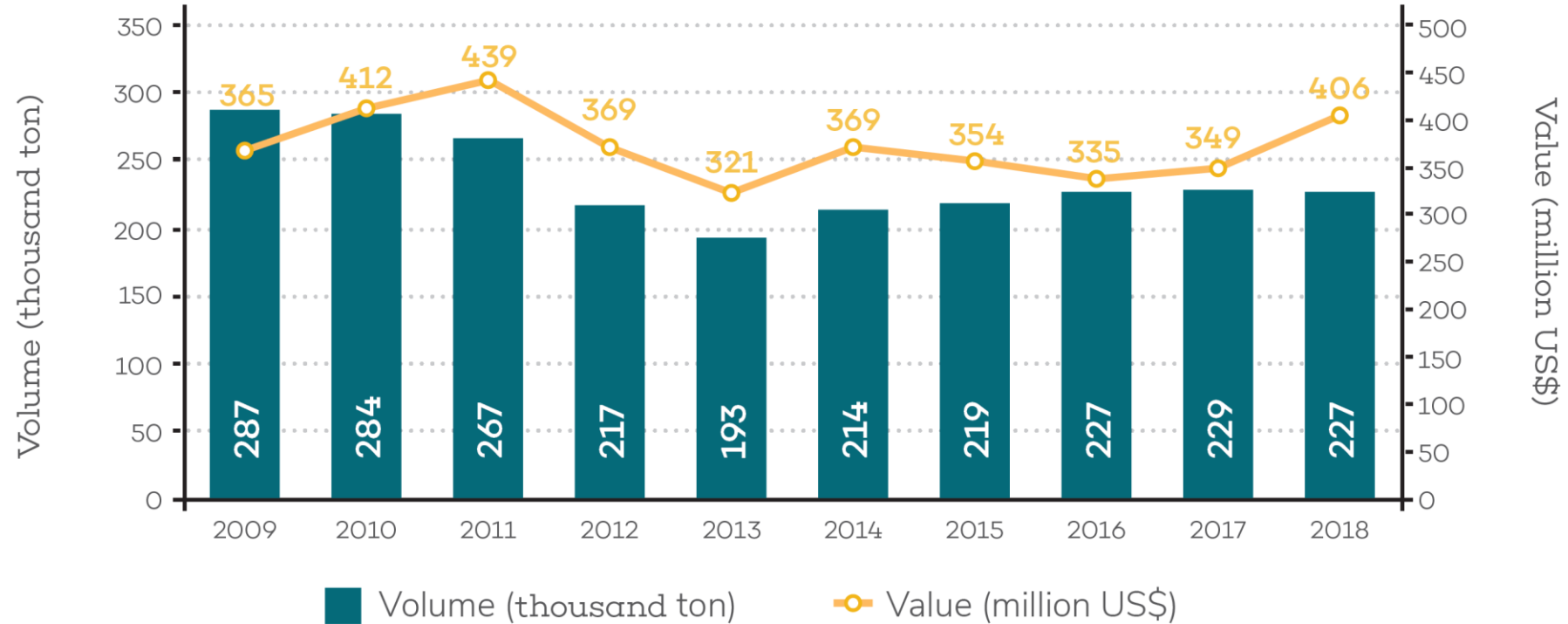




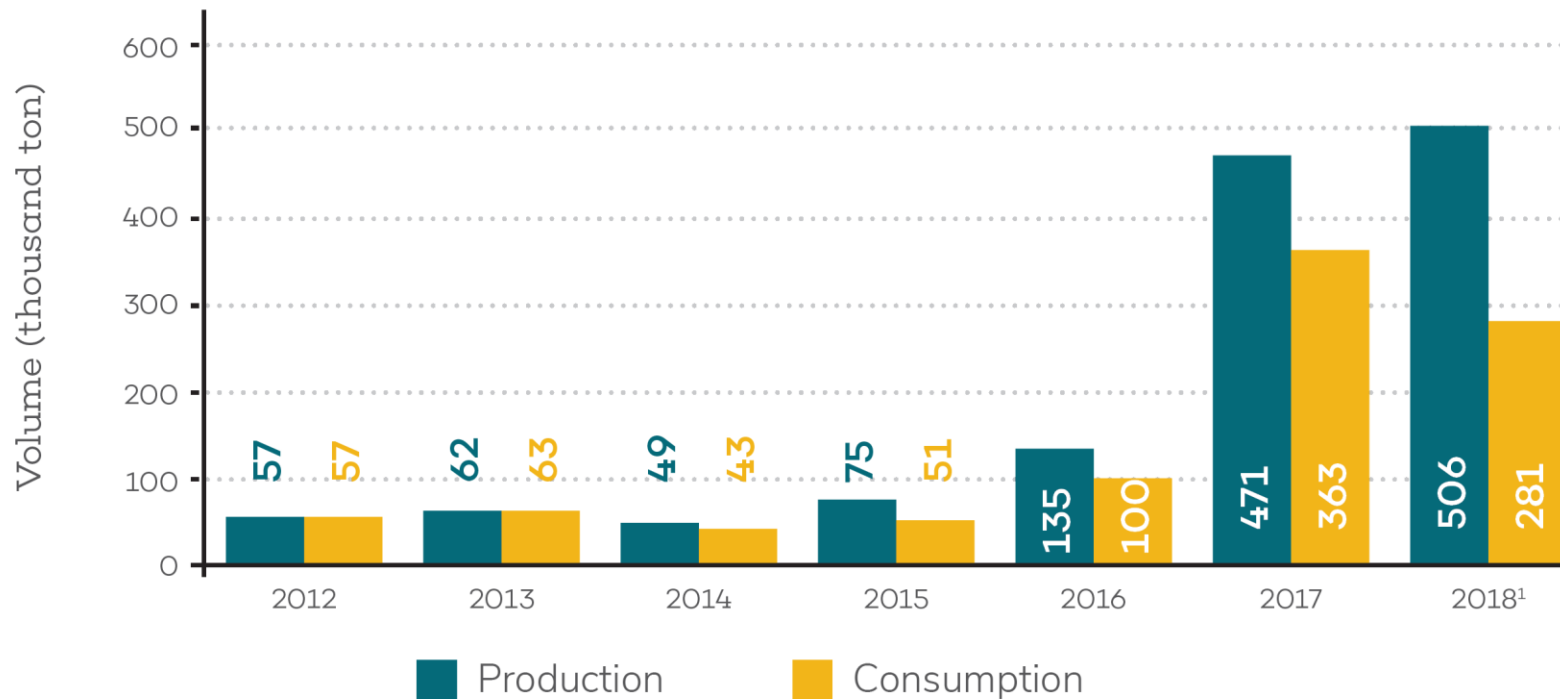


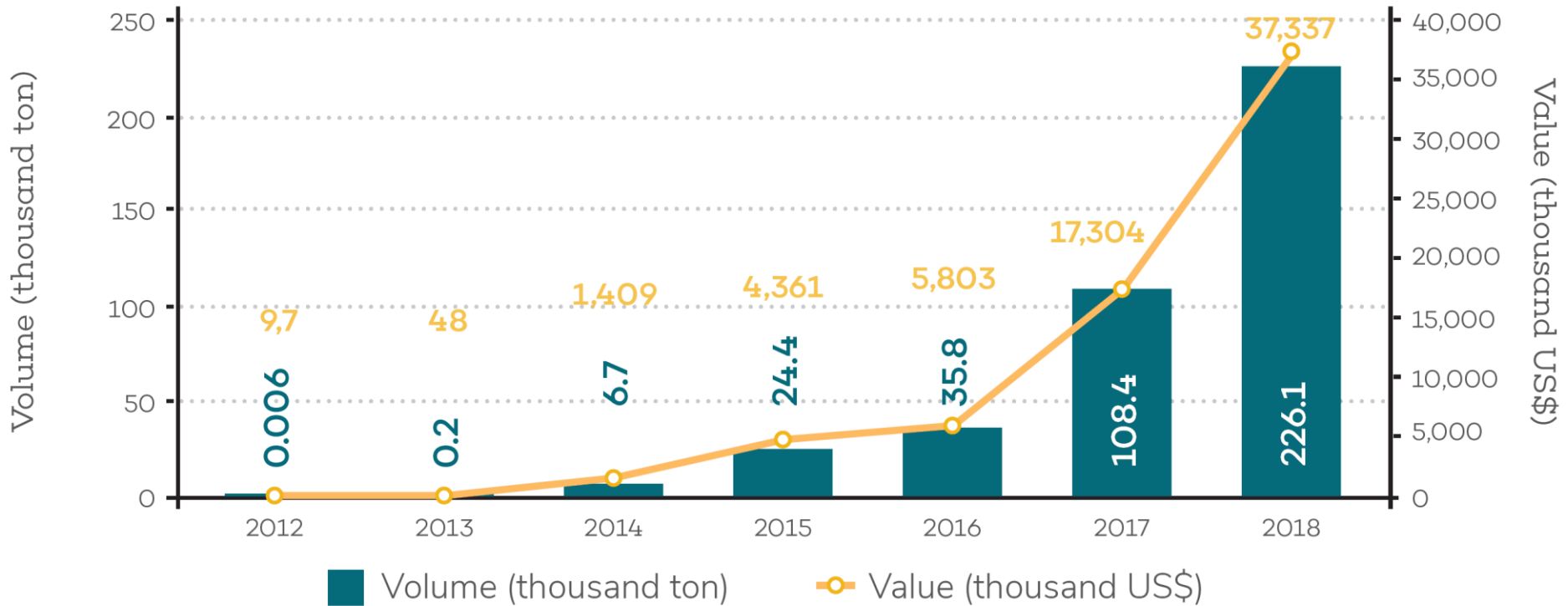






BRAZIL'S WOOD PELLETS DOMESTIC PRODUCTION AND CONSUMPTION TREND (2012-2018)

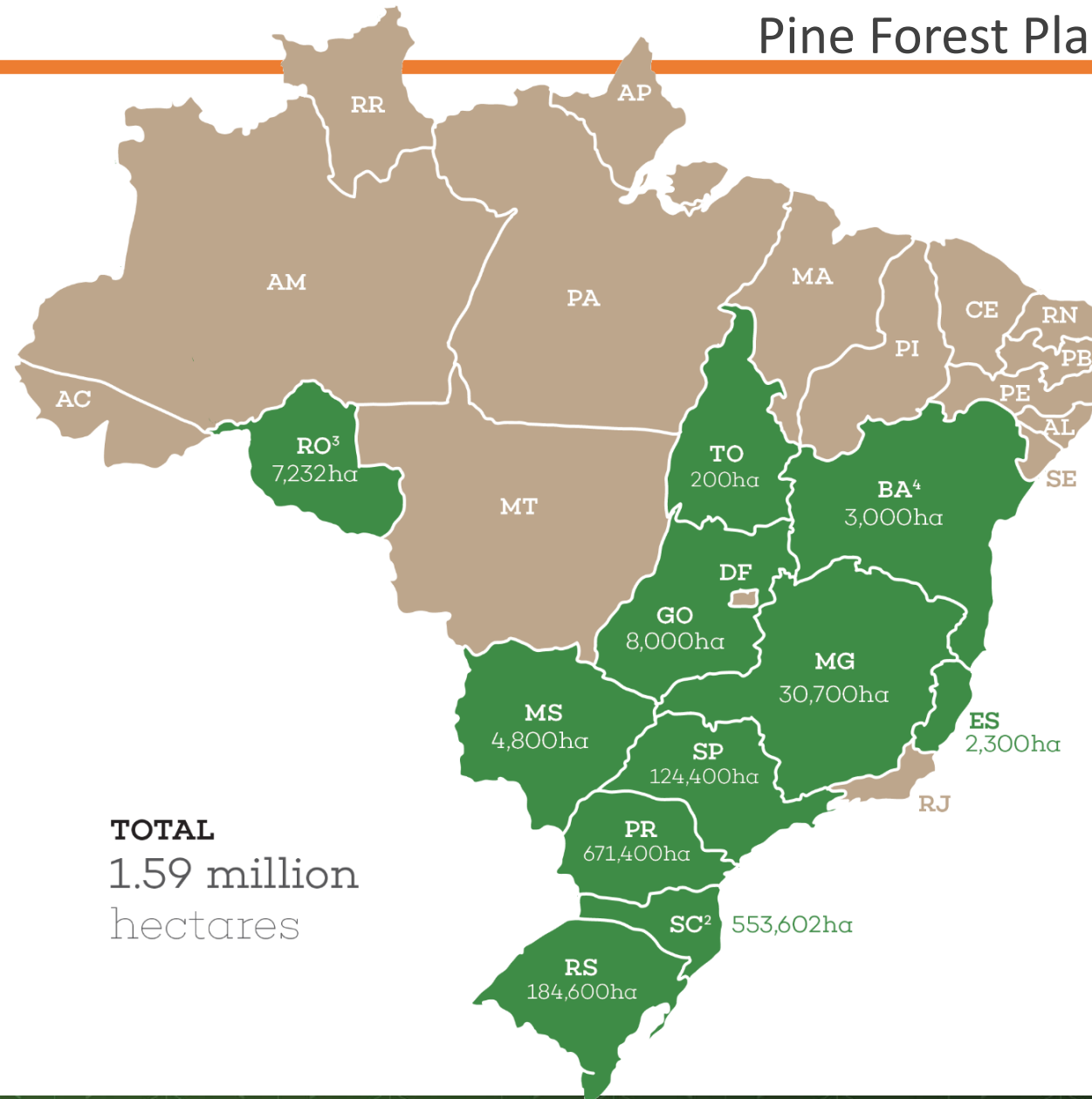
Planted Area

Group (2018¹).





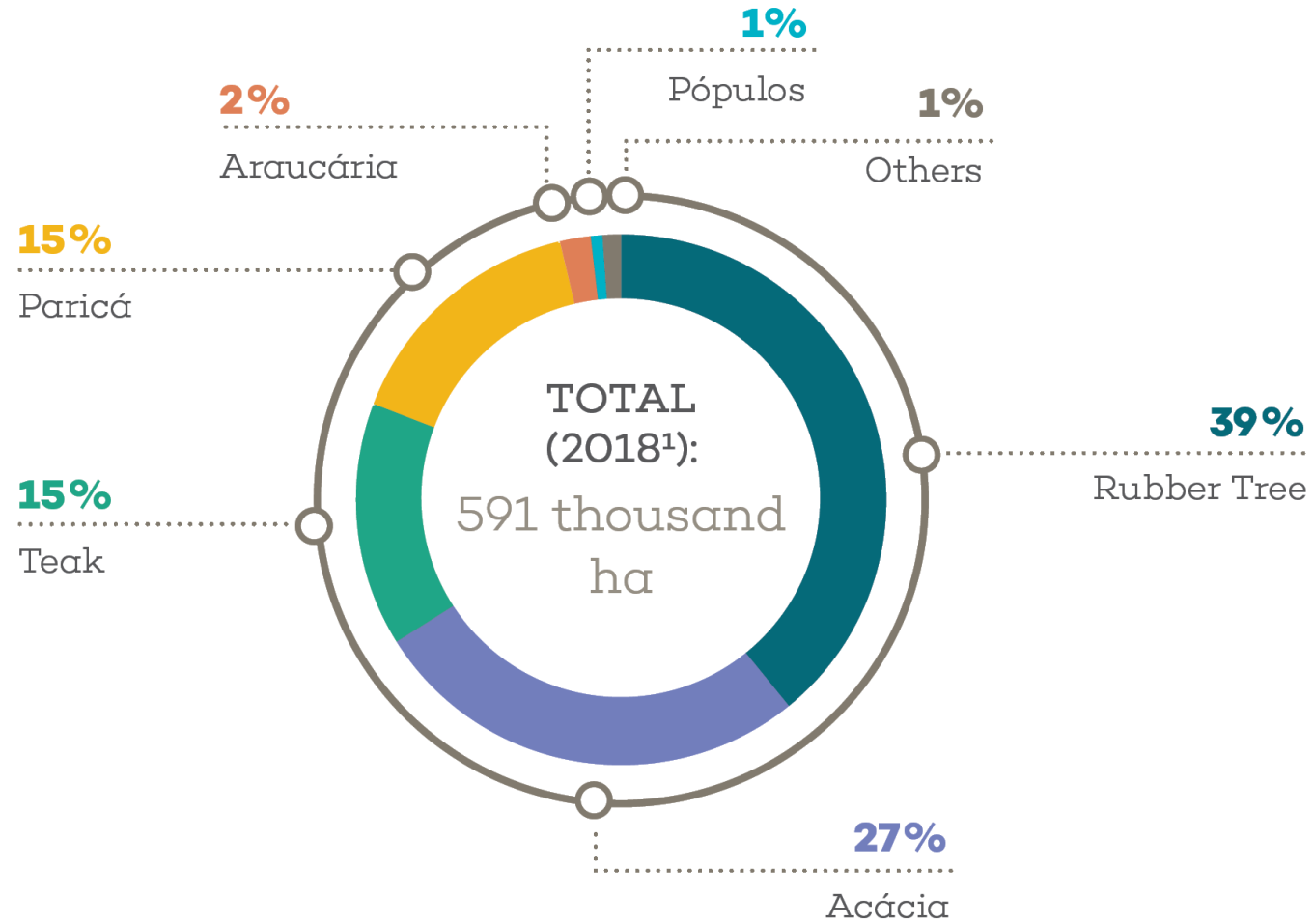
